<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a "No Smoking" sign was not displayed in a conspicuous place at the main entrance. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number(s) 1, 2, 3, and 4 below, were in the children's restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.

- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other [ ].

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post and implement the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan" when necessary.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" were not followed as noted in number 2 (infant play area and the gross motor area) below:

- 1. The plan was not posted in each classroom.
- 2. The plan was not posted in other spaces used by children.
- 3. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.
- 4. The location of first aid kit, fire extinguishers and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.
- 5. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department, hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency, and police department were not complete.
- 6. Location of children's records was not complete.
- 7. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.
- 8. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
- 9. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have enough equipment for all children in care.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment, materials, and furnishings provided for indoor and outdoor play did not meet the requirement of the rule as noted in number(s) [ ] below:

- 1. Not varied and adequate to meet the developmental needs of the children;
- 2. Not sufficient that each child can be actively involved in an activity.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have an area for children to store their belongings.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have designated storage areas for children's personal belongings. The rule requires that an area be designated where children can individually store their personal belongings. This area shall not block walkways or evacuation routes. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have enough equipment for all children in care.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in the following categories were not provided in sufficient quantities for children in the following classroom, as required by the rule:

Infants: 6, 8, 10 Toddler: 1, 2, 9, 10 Preschool: 1, 3, 7

1. Art supplies (excludes infants);

- 2. Manipulative materials and equipment;
- 3. Blocks;
- 4. Science-nature equipment (excludes infants);
- 5. Language arts and auditory materials and equipment;
- 6. Pretend or dramatic play materials;
- 7. Music equipment;
- 8. Transportation materials and equipment;
- 9. Gross motor equipment;
- 10. Sensory motor equipment.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan <u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the fire and weather plans.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following information was not posted for item number(s) 1, 2, 3 in the infant play area and the gross motor area below:

- 1. Fire alert plan, including a diagram indicating evacuation routes.
- 2. Weather alert plan was missing details for [ ].
- 3. Weather alert plan was missing a diagram indicating evacuation routes.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 First Aid/Standard Precautions

Code: The program is required to have a first aid kit onsite.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined first aid kit(s) at the program had missing, or expired, items that are required by appendix A of this rule to be contained in a first aid kit, as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The program did not have a first aid kit onsite.
- 2. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape.
- 3. Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes.
- 4. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes.
- 5. Tweezers.
- 6. Gauze rolled bandage.
- 7. Triangular bandage.
- 8. Rounded end scissors.
- 9. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only).
- 10. A working digital thermometer.
- 11. Disposable non-latex gloves.
- 12. A working flashlight.
- 13. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit.
- 14. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids.
- 15. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration.
- 16. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only).
- 17. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. Include a written statement that a complete kit is now available onsite at the program. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Management of Communicable Disease

Code: The program is required to post the JFS 08087 "Ohio Communicable Disease Chart".

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the JFS 08087 "Ohio Communicable Disease Chart" was not posted as required, as indicated in number 1 below:

- 1. The chart was not posted.
- 2. In a location readily available to program staff and parents.
- 3. The posted chart was not the current version.
- 4. The posted chart was not displayed in the size available in the ODJFS forms central to be easily read.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Diapering and Toilet Training

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to have adequate supplies for diapering available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the required supplies were not available for diaper changing as noted in number(s) 1 and 2 below:

- 1. There was no disposable separation material;
- 2. There was no germicidal solution for sanitizing;
- 3. There were no plastic containers or bags for the storage of soiled clothing;
- 4. Other [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care**

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to put all crib matresses in their lowest position.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the mattress support was not maintained at the lowest position for all cribs when in use, as required. Except when infants are being placed in cribs, removed from cribs, or being soothed, the sides should remain in the highest position. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

- 3. First Aid trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by the program.
- 4. CPR child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had expired training

- 5. CPR child care staff scheduled during all operating hours of 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM had did not have verification of completion of CPR
- 6. CPR trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by children
- 7. CPR training taken by staff was not appropriate for all ages and developmental levels of the children in care
- 8. CPR audiovisual or electronic media training taken by staff did not include an in-person component of the training
- 9. Communicable Disease child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had expired training
- 10. Communicable Disease child care staff scheduled during all operating hours of 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM had not taken Communicable Disease training
- 11. Communicable Disease trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by the program
- 12. Child Abuse child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had expired training
- 13. Child Abuse child care staff scheduled during the hours of operation 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM had not taken Child Abuse training
- 14. Child Abuse trained child care staff was not in each building used by the program
