Findings: During the inspection, it was determined there were 13 children in care during the hours of operation, which is over the capacity listed on the license. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Code: The program is required to remove an infant from a crib to sleep if the infant is able to climb out of the crib, is 35' tall or mor, or if the crib is considered hazardous for the infant.

<u>Findings:</u> During the inspection, it was determined that toddler was placed in/ assigned to a crib/playpen and the condition in number(s) 3 had been met:

- 1. The child is able to climb out of the crib/playpen;
- 2. The child is 35" tall or more;
- 3. The crib/playpen is considered hazardous for the toddler and the mesh was torn.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Daily Care

Code: The program staff is required to hold infants or have the infant sitting up while feeding. The program staff may not place an infant in a crib or playpen with a bottle.

<u>Findings:</u> During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not meet the requirements for bottle feeding as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. A bottle was propped for an infant feeding.
- 2. A toddler was placed in a crib or playpen with a bottle.
- 3. An infant was not held or fed sitting up for bottle feedings.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
