<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number(s) 12 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
- 12. Other: kitchen hazards in the indoor route to the outside playspace, that children would travel through.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from immediate risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a fence in good repair, or other barrier. The fence or gate was not in good repair and/or being used inappropriately as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The fencing had missing slat boards. (no fence had been provided)
- 2. The fencing was broken.
- 3. The fencing was loose.
- 4. The fencing was rotting.
- 5. The gate was broken and did not close.
- 6. The gate was locked.
- 7. The latch on the gate was broken.
- 8. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
- 9. The gate had no latch.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a shaded area was needed and had not been provided in the outdoor play area to protect children from prolonged exposure to the sun. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.
