Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: Meals and snacks provided or served by the program must include all required food groups and meet the recommended daily dietary allowances as specified by the USDA.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a meal or snack at the program did not meet the requirements as noted in number(s) 7 & 9 below:

- 1. The breakfast served did not include foods from three of the four good groups.
- 2. Snack served did not include foods from two of the four food groups.
- 3. The meal did not provide 1/3 of the recommended daily dietary allowances as specified by the USDA.
- 4. Juice used to meet the fruit or snack component was not 100% undiluted fruit or vegetable juice.
- 5. The meal served did not include an item from the meat or meat alternative group.
- 6. The meal served did not include an item from the bread or grain group.

- 7. The meal served did not include two items from the fruit/vegetable group.
- 8. The meal served did not include a vegetable (two fruits were served).
- 9. The meal served did not include a serving of fluid milk.

- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed.
- 3. The original attendance documentation was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

- 2. Prior to departure.
- 3. Upon entry into a classroom.
- 4. After toileting or assisting a child with toileting.
- 5. After each diaper change or pull-up change.
- 6. After contact with bodily fluids or cleaning up spills or objects contaminated with bodily fluids.
- 7. After cleaning or sanitizing or using any chemical products.
- 8. After handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet.
- 9. Before eating, serving or preparing food or bottles or feeding a child.
- 10. Before and after completing a medical procedure or administering medication.
- 11. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water).
- 12. Other [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 1. Upon arrival.
- 2. Prior to departure.
- 3. After toileting/diaper change.
- 4. After contact with bodily fluids.
- 5. After returning from outdoor play.
- 6. After handling pets, pet cages, or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet, before moving on to another activity.
- 7. Before eating or assisting with food preparation.
- 8. After water activities.
- 9. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water)
- 10. Other [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not providing a clean and healthy environment, furniture, materials and equipment as required by Appendix A, as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The changing table was not sanitized after each use.
- 2. Reusable cloths were not being cleaned daily or when visibly soiled.
- 3. Dividers were not cleaned when visibly soiled.
- 4. The food prep areas were not being cleaned and sanitized before and after food prep.
- 5. The food prep areas were not being cleaned and sanitized between preparing raw and cooked food.
- 6. Toilet seat(s), handle(s) and toilet bowl(s) were not being cleaned when visibly soiled and sanitized.
- 7. The sinks were not clean.
- 8. Diaper receptacles were not being cleaned and sanitized.
- 9. Potty chairs were not emptied and/or cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- 10. Wastebaskets/trash receptacles/rinse buckets were not being cleaned and sanitized when visibly soiled.
- 11. Other [ ].

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

#### **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number(s) 3 below:

1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.

- 2. Telephone cords
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [ ].
- 12. Other [ ].

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to use straps on equipment that is manufactured with straps.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following equipment was not used according to manufacturer's guidelines as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. The straps were missing on the [ ].
- 2. The straps were attached, but were not used on the changing table.
- 3. The straps were attached and were used, but were not used in a safe manner.
- 4. Manufacturer's guidelines for the [ ] were not followed in that [ ].

- 2. Manipulative materials and equipment; (all rooms)
- 3. Blocks; (all rooms)
- 4. Science-nature equipment (excludes infants); (all rooms)
- 5. Language arts and auditory materials and equipment;
- 6. Pretend or dramatic play materials; (infant)
- 7. Music equipment; (all classrooms)
- 8. Transportation materials and equipment; (all classrooms)
- 9. Gross motor equipment;
- 10. Sensory motor equipment. (all rooms)

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in at least five of the nine categories listed below were not provided in sufficient quantities for the school-age children in the classroom, as required by the rule:

- 2. Manipulative materials and equipment;

- 7. Transportation materials and equipment;

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.



# Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the current weekly menu in a noticeable location that is accessible to parents and note any substitutions at the time of the change.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu did not meet the requirement as noted in number(s) 3 & 4 below.

- 1. The menu was not posted.
- 2. The posted menu was not in a visible place readily accessible to parents.
- 3. The menu was not currently dated.
- 4. The entire menu was substituted.
- 5. At least one item on menu did not match what was served.
- 6. The meal or snack served did not match the posted menu.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 12/03/2022

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Fluid Milk Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to serve age-appropriate fluid milk or obtain written documentation when serving substitutions for fluid milk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that required documentation for substitutions for fluid milk was not on file as noted in number(s) 5 below:

- 1. Written instructions from a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or certified nurse practitioner when infants up to 12 months of age are served anything other than formula or breast milk.
- 2. Written instructions from a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or certified nurse practitioner when infants and toddlers 12 months of age up to 24 months of age are served anything other than unflavored whole homogenized vitamin D fortified cow's milk, breast milk, or non-cow milk substitution that is nutritionally equivalent to milk.
- 3. Written instructions from a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or certified nurse practitioner when toddlers and children 24 months of age and older are served anything other than unflavored one per cent milk

that is vitamin A and D fortified, unflavored fat free or skim milk that is vitamin A and D fortified, or non-cow milk substitutions that are nutritionally equivalent to milk.

- 4. Written parental consent for non-cow milk substitutions that are nutritionally equivalent to milk for children 12 months of age and older.
- 5. The program did not have the type of milk on-site to ensure that all children were served age-appropriate fluid milk.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 12/03/2022

#### Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program staff is required to label bottles containing formula or breast milk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that bottles containing [breast milk/formula] for a particular infant were not labeled with the child's name and date of preparation. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

# **Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care**

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Diapering and Toilet Training

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to follow diaper changing procedures.

<u>Finding</u>: During this inspection, it was determined that proper diaper changing procedures were not followed as the contents of the common container became contaminated. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Orientation Training & Whistle Blower Protection

Code: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that child care staff member(s) had not completed the online orientation training as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. Within 30 days of starting employment at the program as a child care staff member.
- 2. No documentation of completing the training after December 31, 2016.
- 3. Completion of the training was not verified in the OPR.

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created a profile.
- 2. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member had not created an employment record for the program on or before their first day of employment.
- 3. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member had not updated changes to positions or roles within five calendar days of the change.
- 4. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard.
- 5. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 6. At least one individual's position or role did not include an applicable group assignment.
- 7. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 8. Other: [ ]

- 10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of

conscience, including religious convictions
