Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing potentially hazardous items, toxic substances, and outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous toxic substance was used and stored where children present had access to it as noted in number 1 and 14 below. The potentially hazardous substance and item that posed a risk to children was determined to be accessible to children in the kitchen and upstairs bedroom.

Code: The program is required to protect children from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined the program did not protect children from an unsafe item due to the following number 17 below:

- 2. Extension cord(s); electrical cord(s) attached to an object that could result in a severe injury if pulled.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Medical/Physical Care Plan" on file for each health condition for each child.

Findings: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms, or a medical procedure be performed, or ongoing administration of medication or medical foods at the program. In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was either not on file, implemented or followed, for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in number 1 below:

- 14. Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 15. Directions regarding additional services, if applicable, were missing.
- 16. Dated signature of parent giving permission to perform the procedure was missing.
- 17. Dated signature of program administrator was missing.
- 18. The plan was not implemented.
- 19. The plan was not followed.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care", to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers In the Livingroom. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

- 3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet was not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
