<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the placement of cots or mats in the preschool nap room did not meet the requirements as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The placement did not allow for a clear pathway to each cot.
- 2. Cots or mats blocked exits.

Rule: 5101:2-12-19 Child Guidance

<u>Code</u>: The program staff shall use developmentally appropriate techniques when managing children's behavior. Corporal punishment is prohibited, as well as any cruel, harsh, unusual or extreme techniques.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline child(ren) that was not developmentally appropriate, consistent, or occurred at the time of the incident.
