Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals and machinery in a place that is inaccessible to children. The program is required to provide an outdoor play area away from machinery in operation.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored in the Koala room where children had access to it, as noted in number(s) 2 below.

- 1. Bleach.
- 2. Cleaning agent. (a wet mop, with the cleaning canister attached, with a liquid that smells like ammonia inside)
- 3. Fish tank chemicals.
- 4. Gasoline.
- 5. Pesticide.
- 6. Poison, including insect/rodent poison.
- 7. Flammable substance.
- 8. Windshield washer fluid.
- 9. Aerosol cans.

- 10. A lawn mower.
- 11. A weed trimmer.
- 12. Hedge trimmers.
- 13. A snow blower.
- 14. Other potentially hazardous substance, equipment or machinery: [ ].

Provide staff training. <u>Code</u>: The program is required to store medication out of the reach of children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a medication, Children's Pain & Fever, was within the reach of children in the Koalas room. The medication was observed in a side, open pocket of a diaper bag which was on the lowest shelf of the child's cubby, accessible to all children. All medications must be stored out of the reach of children. Create procedures that assure medications will always be inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for those employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not include the required information listed below in number(s) 3(a).

- 1. Date of examination;
- 2. Signature, business address, and telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination;
- 3. A statement that verifies that the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;

- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 4. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test
- a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the World Health Organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment;
- b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 4a;
- c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test;
- d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
