Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to anchor equipment to the ground as required, to close "S" hooks to prevent the chain from slipping off and prevent strangulation and provide equipment with openings that will not pose a safety risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment on the outdoor play space posed an imminent risk of harm to a child as noted in number(s) 7 below:

- 1. The climber was not anchored.
- 2. The swings were not securely anchored.
- 3. The slide was not securely anchored.
- 4. The climbing rope was not securely anchored at both ends.
- 5. The "S" hooks on the climber were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.
- 6. The "S" hooks on the swing(s) were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.
- 7. The red structure and blue slides structure had an opening that was greater than three and one-half inches, but less than nine inches. Equipment openings must be less than 3 1/2 inches or more than 9 inches to avoid the risk of entrapment.

Discontinue the use of this equipment until it has been removed, repaired or replaced. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide cribs that meet the standards specified by the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission for all infants in attendance. Cribs must be stable and have bars that meet the spacing and size requirements listed in rule. The program is required to refrain from stacking cribs that are used for sleeping infants.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one crib in the infant area did not meet the standards set forth in the rule and the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) safety standards as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The crib was manufactured prior to June 28, 2011 and/or the program did not have a certificate of compliance on file.
- 2. The crib was broken.
- 3. The crib was missing hardware.
- 4. The crib was leaning and/or not stable.
- 5. The crib had corner posts that exceeded more than one sixteenth of an inch above the top of the end panel.
- 6. The spaces between the bars of the crib, or between the bars and end panels of a crib, exceeded two and three-eighths inches.
- 7. Stacked cribs were used for a sleeping infant. Repair or replace the crib(s).

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide nonskid rugs and correct any floor hazard that may be unsafe.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program had a floor surface that was unsafe, in that, the carpeting/baseboards are frayed in the Activity and School-Age rooms. A walking surface that is not hazardous to children must be maintained at the program. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time. Please submit a statement verifying compliance.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals in a place that is inaccessible to children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in number(s) 2; 8 below:

- 2. Disinfecting wipes;
- 3. Fish food;

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the blue slide structure-ladder and rocking animals were positioned such that the fall zone requirement in number(s) 2 below was not met:

- 1. The fall zone was less than 3 feet from the fence for equipment used by children 23 months of age and younger.
- 2. The fall zone was less than 6 feet from the fence for equipment used by children 24 months of age and older.
- 3. There was not a fall zone of 3 feet in all directions from the perimeter of the equipment used by children 23 months of age and younger.
- 4. There was not a fall zone of 6 feet in all directions from the perimeter of the equipment used by children 24 months of age and older.
- 5. The fall zone was less than 4 1/2 feet from each piece of applicable equipment used by children 23 months of age and younger.
- 6. The fall zone was less than 9 feet from each piece of applicable equipment used by children 24 months of age and older.
