## **Complaint Allegations**

## Domain:01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5180:2-12-19 Supervision

Code: The program staff is required to supervise children in their assigned group by sight and hearing. Supervision includes being near enough to respond and reach children immediately and protecting them from harm.

Allegation: A child was left unattended indoors.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that children were left unattended while inside the program as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. Child was left unattended once.
- 2. Child(ren) were left unattended more than once.
- 3. A child left the group and was unattended. A child was left unsupervised in the indoor gross motor room. During the transition from the gross motor room to the classroom, the assigned staff failed to observe that one child had separated from the group and re-entered the gross motor room. The child remained unattended for approximately 15 to 20 minutes until another staff member located the child and escorted them back to the classroom.
- 4. Child care staff were using a baby monitor to supervise children.
- 5. Child care staff were using a walkie talkie to supervise children.
- 6. Child care staff were using mirrors to view children in another room.
- 7. Child care staff were using a video camera instead of physically being present in the room.
- 8. Other [ ].

Children must be supervised and within sight and hearing of a child care staff member at all times. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
