Code: The program staff is required to provide true and accurate information.

Allegation: Allegedly the program is cooking food.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program provided false information, in that the administrator designee, stated that the food service license was in the mail and would send documentation of payment indicating the administrator had taken care of it. In communication with the Dayton Montgomery County Health Department - the Food Service License has not been renewed as no payment has been received. The rule requires the program to provide accurate and truthful information to the Department. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program administrator and owner are required to provide true and accurate information.

Allegation: Allegedly the program does not have a current fire inspection.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program provided false information, in that the posted (on wall of walkway to the office/classroom space) current fire inspection, dated 12/12/2023, was observed at this complaint investigation has been determined as falsified. The rule requires the program to provide accurate and truthful information to the Department. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

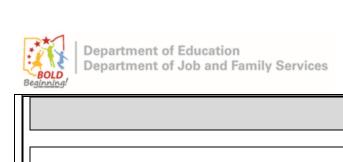

Domain:00 License & Approvals

Rule: 5101:2-12-04 Food Service Requirements

Code: The program is required to obtain and maintain a valid food license if they prepare and/or serve food. The program is required to correct any food service violations to maintain their food service license.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program failed to obtain or maintain a valid food service license as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. The program was unable to obtain the food service license due to violations.
- 2. The program was unable to maintain the food service license due to violations.
- 3. The program prepared and/or served food without obtaining/renewing a valid food service license. The local health department must be contacted so the health official may determine whether the program meets exemption status, or whether the program needs a food service license.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the food service license or exemption status, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
