Code: The program is required to meet all requirements for carbon monoxide detectors.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the Type B Home did not have a working carbon monoxide detectors in the program room and in the main entrance of the home where children enter. Carbon monoxide detectors were not installed accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. A working carbon monoxide detector must be placed, installed, tested, and maintained in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. Code: The program is required to receive a preliminary approval from ODJFS prior to allowing an individual to engage in assigned duties or be near children.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background checks did not meet the requirements of the rule for the person listed on the Employee Record Chart as noted in number 2 below:

- 3. The individual(s) had engaged in assigned duties or were near children and preliminary approval from ODJFS was not on file.

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any item which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 23 below:

- 1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers;
- 2. Open pull cords that are not closed loop;
- 3. Toys or other items small enough to be swallowed were present in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care;
- 4. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled;
- 5. Stacked chairs;
- 6. Telephone cords;
- 7. Stacked chairs;
- 8. Employee(s) purse(s);
- 9. Diaper bags;
- 10. Television not securely anchored;
- 11. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall;
- 12. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child;
- 13. Chipping or peeling paint;
- 14. An area rug did not have a nonskid backing;
- 15. An area rug presented a tripping hazard;

- 16. A floor surface was unsafe in that [];
- 17. No platform was provided for the sink or toilet;
- 18. The platform provided for the sink or toilet was not sturdy;
- 19. The platform provided for the sink or toilet posed a safety hazard in that [];
- 20. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture in that [];
- 21. A mercury thermometer was being used to take a child's temperature.
- 22. Methods of ventilation used did not provide protection from rodents, insects, or other hazards.
- 23. Knife in drawer.

Code: The program is required to have running water below the temperature of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

- 10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of
