Rule: 5180:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide adequate fall surface for the outdoor play space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the playground did not have adequate fall surface under and around equipment as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. No fall surface
- 2. Adequate fall surface to soften the impact of a fall
- 3. Adequate fall surface to soften the impact of a fall that extended the length of the required fall zone
- 4. Other []

With any equipment designed for climbing, swinging, bouncing, or sliding, resilient material, as specified in Appendix A, needs to be added in order to protect children in the event of a fall. - 2. Weather alert plan was missing the weather details from the program's disaster plan.
- 3. Weather alert plan was missing a diagram indicating evacuation routes.

Rule: 5180:2-12-16 First Aid/Standard Precautions

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a first aid kit onsite.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined first aid kit(s) at the program had missing, or expired, items that are required by appendix A of this rule to be contained in a first aid kit, as noted in numbers 5, 6, 10, 12, 13, 15 below:

- 1. The program did not have a first aid kit [onsite, on the vehicle, on a field trip].
- 2. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape.
- 3. Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes.
- 4. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes.
- 5. Tweezers.
- 6. Gauze rolled bandage.



- 7. Triangular bandage.
- 8. Rounded end scissors.
- 9. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only).
- 10. A working digital thermometer.
- 11. Disposable non-latex gloves.
- 12. A working flashlight.
- 13. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit.
- 14. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids.
- 15. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration.
- 16. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only).
- 17. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program staff is required to label bottles containing formula or breast milk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that bottles containing milk/formula for a particular infant were not labeled with the child's name and date of preparation. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to label all cribs.



<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one crib was not labeled with the child's name, as required by this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180:2-12-23 Infant Daily Care

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to hold infants or have the infant sitting up while feeding. The program staff may not place an infant in a crib with a bottle.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not meet the requirements for bottle feeding as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. A bottle was propped for an infant feeding.
- 2. An infant was placed in a crib with a bottle.
- 3. An infant was not held or fed sitting up for bottle feedings.

Rule: 5180:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in numbers 2, 3, 5, 6 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.

- 13. Child Abuse child care staff scheduled during the hours of [] and [] had not taken Child Abuse training
- 14. Child Abuse trained child care staff was not in each building used by the program
