Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Outdoor Space

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from immediate risk.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a continuous fence in good condition, or natural barrier, that ensured children were not able to leave the playground area. The fence or natural barrier was determined to present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground as noted in number 10 below:

- 1. The fence, natural barrier, or combination of fence and natural barrier was not continuous.
- 2. The fencing had missing slat boards through which children could leave the playground.
- 3. The gate was broken and did not close.
- 4. The latch on the gate was broken.
- 5. The gate had no latch.
- 6. The fencing was broken.
- 7. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
- 8. The latch was not engaged to prevent children from opening the gate.
- 9. The portable fencing approved for use by the Department was not being used.
- 10. Other -Children were using the front porch and the front sidewalk which do not have continuous protective barriers.



Discontinue use of the playground and provide a space for outdoor play which is well defined by a continuous fence or natural barrier and protected from other hazards. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 22 below:

- 1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers.
- 2. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 3. Toys or other items small enough to be swallowed were present in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care.
- 4. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- Stacked chairs.
- 6. Telephone cords.
- 7. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 8. Diaper bags.
- 9. Television not securely anchored.
- 10. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 11. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 12. Chipping or peeling paint.
- 13. An area rug did not have a nonskid backing.
- 14. An area rug presented a tripping hazard.
- 15. A floor surface was unsafe in that [].
- 16. No platform was provided for the sink or toilet.
- 17. The platform provided for the sink or toilet was not sturdy.
- 18. The platform provided for the sink or toilet posed a safety hazard in that [].
- 19. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture in that [].
- 20. A mercury thermometer was being used to take a child's temperature.
- 21. Methods of ventilation used did not provide protection from rodents, insects, or other hazards.
- 22. Other -dog leashes hanging on back of door leading to garage pose safety hazard.



Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Emergency Preparedness and Response Plan

Code: The program is required to train child care staff members and employees on the written emergency preparedness and response plan annually and keep written documentation of the training on-site.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program's written emergency and preparedness and response plan did not meet the requirement for training child care staff members and employees on the plan annually as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. Child care staff members and employees were not trained annually.
- 2. Written documentation of the training was not kept on file.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 First Aid Kit/Standard Precautions

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit onsite as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit was missing the item or the item was not replaced after use and/or expired listed in number 5 below:

- 1. One roll of first-aid tape;
- Individually wrapped sterile gauze;

squares in assorted sizes;

- 3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
- 4.Tweezers;
- Gauze rolled bandage;
- 6. Triangular bandage;
- 7. Rounded end scissors:
- 8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);



- 9. A working digital thermometer;
- 10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
- 11. A working flashlight;
- 12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;
- 13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;
- 14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;
- 15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);
- 16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-10 Health Training

Code: Child care staff members and substitute child care staff members are required to complete health

trainings within the first ninety days of hire and prior to being left alone with children.

Findings: In review of records, it was determined the CCSM or Substitute CCSM did not meet health training requirements listed in number 2 below:

- 1. All health trainings were not completed prior to being left alone with children.
- 2. First Aid training was not completed within the first ninety days of hire.
- 3. CPR training was not completed within the first ninety days of hire.
- 2. Communicable Disease training was not completed within the first ninety days of hire.
- 3. Child Abuse training was not completed within the first ninety days of hire.

Correct the violation and submit the documentation of current certification with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-08 Employee Requirements

Code: The program is required to obtain completed medical statements for all program staff.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that a medical statement for an individual listed on the Employee Record Chart did not include the required information listed below in number(s) 5b and 5c.

1. A medical statement was not on file;



- 2. The medical statement(s) on file were not dated within 12 months of the individual's first day of employment;
- 3. Date of examination was missing;
- 4. Signature, business address, or telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination was missing;
- 5. A statement was missing that verifies the individual is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed medical statement, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in numbers 4, 9, 10, & 13 below:

- 1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
- 2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
- 3. Complete child information
- 4. Complete parent information
- 5. Complete emergency contact information
- 6. Complete physician information
- 7. Information regarding the parent list
- 8. Health information
- 9. Additional information for all boxes checked "yes"
- 10. Emergency transportation information
- 11. Parent/guardian's signature
- 12. Diapering Statement
- 13. Acknowledgement of Policies and Procedures
- 14. Enrollment form for at least one child was not updated by either the parent or the administrator
- 15. Enrollment form for at least one child was not signed by the administrator

Code: The program staff is required to obtain signed written permission for administering topical products and lotions other than lip balm and hand sanitizer, when using hand sanitizer with children older than 24 months.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program staff did not obtain signed written permission from the parent prior to administering topical products and lotions, other than hand sanitizer to be used by children older than twenty-four months and lip balm. Permission needs to include the name of the topical product/lotion. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
