#### **Serious Risk Non-Compliances**

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to have firearms and ammunition secured.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined there were weapons/firearms on the premises of the program when children were present, as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. Weapons were on the premises of the program and were accessible to children and not secured as required.
- 2. Concealed handgun was not secured by the individual owning the concealed carry permit;
- 3. Individual owning a concealed carry permit had possession of a concealed handgun that was accessible to children;
- 4. Individual did not have valid military identification and documentation of successful completion of firearms training;
- 5. Law Enforcement.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the weapons/firearms have been removed or secured to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing potentially hazardous items, toxic substances, and outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children present had access to it as noted in number 2 below. The potentially hazardous substance or item that posed a risk to children was determined to be accessible to children in the dining room on the table.

- 1. Bleach.
- 2. Cleaning agent.
- 3. Fish tank chemicals.
- 4. Gasoline.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance or item is no longer accessible to children and/or children will not be outside when machinery is in use and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to store medication out of the reach of children.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined medication was in the reach of children. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

# **Low Risk Non-Compliances**

# Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Clean environment and equipment

Code: The program is required to have all required items in the restroom(s) and keep them sanitary.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in the following numbers 3 and 6 below, were in the upstairs restroom:



- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet tissue.
- 3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet was not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other [].

The restroom must be kept sanitary at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

#### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to have running water below the temperature of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the water temperature was 132 degrees Fahrenheit in the following room: upstairs bathroom. This temperature exceeds the requirement of remaining below 120 degrees Fahrenheit. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Clean environment and equipment

Code: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not providing a clean and healthy environment, furniture, materials and equipment as required by Appendix A, as noted in numbers 14,19,20 below:

- 1. Item(s) soiled with blood or bodily fluids were not cleaned/sanitized immediately.
- 2. Blankets/sheets were not cleaned weekly, when soiled, or before use by another child.
- 3. Children's individual blankets and belongings were stored in an unsanitary manner.
- 4. Bottles, bottle caps, nipples and other equipment used for bottle feeding were not cleaned and sanitized in a dishwasher or by washing, rinsing, and boiling for one minute.
- 5. Carpets were not vacuumed weekly or cleaned when soiled.
- 6. Changing table/pad was not sanitized after each use or cleaned when visibly soiled.
- 7. Reusable cloths were not being washed daily or when visibly soiled.



- 8. Cots/Pads/Mats were not cleaned and sanitized before assigning to a different child, when used by a sick child, when soiled or at least every three months.
- 9. Cribs were not cleaned and sanitized monthly, or when soiled, or before use by another child.
- 10. Diaper Receptacles were not cleaned and sanitized daily or more frequently as needed to eliminate odor.
- 11. Dishes/Cups/Silverware were not cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- 12. Water Containers were not labeled with the child's name, or were not cleaned and sanitized before use again on another day.
- 13. Dress up clothes and hats (dramatic play) were not cleaned monthly or when soiled.
- 14. Floors were not cleaned weekly or when soiled.
- 15. The food prep area, including sinks, were not cleaned before and after preparing food (including bottle preparation) or between preparing raw or cooked food.
- 16. Potty chairs were not cleaned after each use, rinsed with water, cleaned and sanitized or contents were not emptied into a toilet.
- 17. Food tables, highchair trays were not cleaned before and after each use.
- 18. Tables used for play were not cleaned when visibly soiled or sanitized daily.
- 19. Toilet bowls were not cleaned when visibly soiled or sanitized weekly.
- 20. Toilet seat and and hand washing sink were not cleaned when visibly soiled or sanitized daily.
- 21. Mouthed toys were not cleaned and sanitized after each child's use.
- 22. Toys, other than those mouthed by children, were not cleaned monthly or when visibly soiled.
- 23. Washable furniture, including fabrics on infant equipment, were not cleaned weekly or when soiled.
- 24. Upholstered furniture was not steam cleaned when soiled.
- 25. Slip covers were not washed at least every six months or when soiled.
- 26. Wastebaskets/rinse buckets, including lids, were not being emptied daily or cleaned and sanitized when visibly soiled.
- 27. The manufacturer's directions for the cleaning product were not followed.
- 28. The solution used for sanitizing was not a commercial product registered by the United States Environmental Protection Agency as a sanitizer.
- 29. Other [ ].

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Emergency Drills

Code: The program is required to complete and document the required drills.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item numbers 2 and 3 below:

- 1. Monthly fire drills
- 2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September)
- 3. Emergency/lockdown drills in each quarter of the calendar year



Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to store first aid supplies in an unlocked, closed first aid container that is

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the first aid supplies were not stored according to the requirements listed in item number 3 below:

- 1. Stored in a closed container
- 2. Stored in a unlocked container
- 3. Stored out of the reach of children
- 4. Stored on the premises
- 5. Stored readily available to the provider

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in numbers 1,3, 4,6,7,9,13 below:

- 1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
- 2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
- 3. Complete child information
- 4. Complete parent information
- 5. Complete emergency contact information
- 6. Complete physician information
- 7. Information regarding the parent list
- 8. Health information
- 9. Additional information for all boxes checked "yes"
- 10. Emergency transportation information
- 11. Parent/guardian's signature

- 13. Acknowledgement of Policies and Procedures
- 14. Enrollment form for at least one child was not updated by either the parent or the administrator

Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file for each child.

Findings: In review of of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in numbers 1 and 8 below:

- 1. No medical was on file for at least one child
- 2. Medical(s) on file was not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. The date of the exam was more than 13 months prior to the date the form was signed
- 6. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care
- 7. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 8. Medicals were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year
- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases

10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
