Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Health Conditions

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" on file at the program for any child having a health condition and must implement and/or follow instructions on the plan. The program is required to have staff trained to perform the procedures on the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" present at the program when the child requiring the procedure is onsite. Only staff who have been trained shall be permitted to perform the procedures listed on the JFS 01236.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for caring for at least one child, indicated on the Children Records Review, with a condition that requires a JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" as noted in number 1,7,19, 31 below:

- 17. Actions to be taken if the symptoms do not subside were missing or not attached.
- 18. Physician's signature was missing or not attached.
- 19. The date of the physician's signature was missing or not attached.

- 22. Signature of parent granting permission to implement the plan and verifying training was missing.

- 43. A child care staff member who had not been trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 performed the procedure.
- 44. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.

## Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to store alcohol in a space not used by children.

Findings: During the inspection, it was observed that a sealed container of alcohol was observed in a space approved or used for child care as noted in the following numbers 1, 2 below:

- 1. A sealed container was observed but children in care did not gain access to the alcohol. During inspection it was observed that there were unopened containers of alcohol in a lower kitchen cupboard.
- 2. A sealed container of alcohol was observed but children in care were not observed in the space at the time of the inspection.

These items must be removed or stored in space not approved or used for children as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-13 Handwashing

Code: The program staff and residents are required to wash their hands at the appropriate times as outlined in

rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the handwashing requirements were not being followed by the provider, program staff, residents, or a child in that hands were not washed prior to departure, 5180:2-13-13 (5101:2-13-13) Appendix B. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 First Aid Kit/Standard Precautions

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit [onsite/ on the vehicle/ on a field trip] as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit(s) were missing the item(s) or the item(s) were not replaced after use and/or expired listed in number 11 below:

- 1. One roll of first-aid tape;
- 2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze;

squares in assorted sizes;

- 3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
- 4.Tweezers;
- 5. Gauze rolled bandage;
- 6. Triangular bandage;
- 7. Rounded end scissors;
- 8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);
- 9. A working digital thermometer;
- 10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
- 11. A working flashlight;
- 12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;
- 13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;
- 14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;
- 15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);
- 16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
