Findings: During the inspection, required staff/child ratios were not maintained for different groups on multiple occasions, as noted below:

The ratio determined for the preschool group was 1 Child Care Staff Member for 17 and 28 children. Additionally, a ratio of 1 Child Care Staff Member for 7 children was determined for the infant group.

Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
