Allegation: It was alleged that individuals were working with children that did not meet child care staff member requirements.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: The allegation is substantiated in that, during the inspection, it was determined that children were being supervised by an individual who did not meet the requirements of a child care staff member in that the cook/employee was walking children from the entry door to the classroom and was covering child care staff members for restroom breaks. Additional child care staff members must be hired or current child care staff members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program’s corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
