Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

Domain:07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to place infants in cribs while sleeping.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the equipment in number(s) 8 below had been used for sleeping infants and did not allow the infant to sleep on a firm mattress:

- 1. Mesh cribs;
- 2. Play pens;



- 3. Bassinets;
- 4. Cots;
- 5. Car seats;
- 6. Infant swing;
- 7. The floor;
- 8. Infant seats;
- 9. An infant placed in a car seat in a crib;
- 10. Other [].

Infants must be provided with a crib, which meets requirements specified in this rule, for resting and sleeping. Provide staff training. Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain:01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5180:2-12-18 Attendance Records

Code: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is also required to retain the original attendance record at the center for a period of one year.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number(s) 2 and 4 below:

- 1. No attendance record was being maintained.
- 2. The attendance record was not being accurately completed in that there were 8 children in attendance but 10 children signed-in on the PK/SA record; one child was moved to the infant room but the 10th child could not be accounted for.
- 3. The record did not include the name of at least one child.
- 4. The record did not include the birth date of at least one child.
- 5. The record did not include the assigned group.
- 6. The record did not include the child's weekly schedule.
- 7. The record did not include the time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.
- 8. The original attendance record was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
