2. Staff member(s) allowed child(ren) to do something unsafe.
3. Staff member(s) did something unsafe.
4. Children were exposed to inappropriate behavior by staff members in that inappropriate words and actions were used by staff during naptime while children were present. Although a video clip was posted of the incident, no children's faces were exposed.
