Rule: 5180:2-13-04 Fire Safety for Type B Homes

Code: The program is required to meet all requirements for fire extinguishers.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the fire extinguisher was not meeting the requirements in the following number(s) 3 listed below:



- 1. There was no fire extinguisher.
- 2. The fire extinguisher was not working.
- 3. The fire extinguisher was not rated at the minimum rating.
- 4. The fire extinguisher had expired.
- 5. The fire extinguisher was not located in the kitchen where food is provided for child care or cooking area.

Code: The program is required to provide a smoke free environment during operating hours, ensure smoking is not seen by children, post a "No Smoking Sign" by the main entrance, provide notification to parents if smoking occurs on the premises outside of operating hours, and refrain from exposing children to smoking paraphernalia.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not maintaining a smoke free environment, as noted in the number(s) below: 3

- 1. The program did not provide a smoke free environment for children during the hours of child care in that [].
- 2. An individual left the home to smoke, however, this smoking occurred in an area within view of the children.
- 3. A "No Smoking" sign was not displayed in a conspicuous place at the main entrance.
- 4. Smoking had occurred in the program or vehicle during hours the program was not in operation; however, parents had not been given written notice of this.
- 5. Children had access and/or were exposed to smoking paraphernalia in that [cigarettes/cigars/pipe butts/ashes/chewing or smokeless tobacco/electronic cigarettes/vaporizers/bong] was/were observed in view of children.

Code: The program is required to post the fire and weather alert plan with a diagram.

- 1. Fire alert plan, including a diagram indicating evacuation routes.
- 2. Weather alert plan was missing details for [].
- 3. Weather alert plan was missing a diagram indicating evacuation routes.

Code: The program is required to post the current menu in a noticeable location that is accessible to parents and note any substitutions at the time of the change.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu did not meet the requirement as noted in number(s) 2, 3 below.

- 1. The menu was not posted.
- 2. The posted menu was not in a visible place readily accessible to parents.



- 3. The menu was not currently dated.
- 4. The entire menu was substituted.
- 5. At least one item on menu did not match what was served.
- 6. The meal or snack served did not match the posted menu.

Code: The program is required to have firm and resilient sleeping equipment

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that all children's sleeping equipment were not firm, resilient and in good repair as required by this rule, as noted in number(s) 6 below:

- 1. Frames were bent/broken
- 2. Covers were torn
- 3. Sleeping equipment were missing bolts
- 4. Sleeping equipment were sagging
- 5. Legs on the sleeping equipment were broken

Code: The program is required to have the applicable JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check

Review for Child Care" on file.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background check requirements had not been followed, for the individual(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart, as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. The JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" the program received from the Department was not on file and the individual was not left alone with children.
- 2. The JFS 01177 "Individual Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" was on file instead of the JFS 01176.
- 3. The JFS 01176 on file was for a different program.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the correct form is now on file, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-09 Background Checks

Code: Individuals are required to completed the background check process and obtain complete results.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background check requirements were incomplete for the individuals listed on the Employee Record Chart, as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. The JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background check Review for Child Care" was not on file at the program, but was on file at the county agency and the individual is eligible.
- 2. The JFS 01176 was not on file at the program, but the BCI and FBI results were on file at the program and the individual had no prohibitive offenses which did not meet the rehabilitation criteria.
- 3. The JFS 01176 was not on file at the program, but the BCI and FBI results were on file at the county agency and the individual had no prohibitive offenses which did not meet the rehabilitation criteria.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the correct form is now on file, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The provider is required to maintain current employee, child care staff members and resident records in

the Ohio Professional Registry.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that employment records in the Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) were not created or maintained as noted in number(s) 2,6,7 below:

- 1. The provider had not created or updated their individual profile in the OPR.
- 2. The provider had not created or updated the program's organizational dashboard in the OPR.
- 3. At least one employee, child care staff member, or substitute child care staff member had not created or updated their individual profile in the OPR.
- 4. At least one employee, child care staff member, or substitute child care staff member had not created an employment record in the OPR for the program on or before the first day of employment, including date of hire.
- 5. At least one employee, child care staff member, or substitute child care staff member had not updated changes to positions or roles in the OPR within five calendar days of the change.
- 6. The program's organizational dashboard in the OPR was not updated within five business days when at least one employee, child care staff member, or substitute child care staff member's scheduled days and hours changed.
- 7. The program's organizational dashboard in the OPR was not updated within five business days when at least one employee, child care staff member, or substitute child care staff member's group assignments changed, if applicable.



- 8. The program's organizational dashboard in the OPR was not updated with the employment end date within five business days when at least one employee, child care staff member, or substitute child care staff member ended employment.
- 9. At least one resident over the age of eighteen had not created a profile and employment record for the family child care provider within five days of becoming a resident or turning eighteen.
- 10. The program's organizational dashboard in the OPR was not updated within five calendar days of a change in residency for at least one resident over the age of eighteen.

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Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-07 Provider Responsibilities

Code: The program is required to have the current licensing rules available in a noticeable area on the premises.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the current licensing rules were not available on the premises. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 03/06/2025

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-07 Provider Responsibilities

Code: The provider is required to reside at the licensed location, not have additional activities or employment during the program's operating hours, be on-site at the program for at least 75 percent of the program's operating hours, and have hours of availability posted in a noticeable place.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the provider was not meeting the following requirements as noted in number(s) 4 below:

- 1. The provider no longer resides at the licensed location.
- 2. The licensed provider has additional activities/employment during operating hours, in that [].
- 3. The provider was not on-site for 75 percent of the program's operating hours as required by this rule.
- 4. The provider did not have hours of availability to meet with parents a noticeable location.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
