<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the area used when children rest, nap or sleep was not lighted sufficiently to allow child care staff visual supervision of the children at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance by submitting a corrective action plan to the department in OCLQS.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training. Additionally, the training must be completed before they are permitted to have sole responsibility of children.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that child care staff member(s) did not meet the requirements for completing the online orientation training as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within 30 days of starting employment at the program as a child care staff member.
- 2. Documentation of completing the training after December 31, 2016 was not on file.
- 3. Completion of the training was not verified in the OPR.
- 4. A child care staff member had sole responsibility of children and had not completed the online orientation.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

1. First Aid – child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [] and [] had expired training



- 2. First Aid child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [] and [] did not have verification of completion of First Aid
- 3. First Aid trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by the program.
