- 2. Extension cord(s); electrical cord(s) attached to an object that could result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 3. Stacked tables.
- 4. Folding tables.
- 5. Matches and/or a lighter.
- 6. Power tool(s).
- 7. Live wires.
- 8. Stove(s) that are either on or able to be turned on by a child.
- 9. Asbestos.
- 10. Traffic.
- 11. A body of water.
- 12. A well.
- 13. Environmental hazard(s) confirmed by local authorities having jurisdiction over the hazard.
- 14. A crockpot used to heat bottles.
- 15. Immediate access to a knife.
- 16. Large or heavy pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 17. Marijuana was accessible to children.
- 18. Other- a razor in the shower.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the Type B Home did not have a working carbon monoxide detector on the second level of the home or carbon monoxide detector were not [placed/installed/tested/maintained] in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. A working carbon monoxide detector must be placed, installed, tested, and maintained in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance is no longer accessible to children and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-17 Materials and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have enough equipment for all children in care.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in the following categories were not provided in sufficient quantities for children as required: 11.

- 1. Art supplies (excludes infants)
- 2. Manipulative materials and equipment
- 3. Blocks
- 4. Science-nature equipment (excludes infants)
- 5. Language arts and auditory materials and equipment
- 6. Pretend or dramatic play materials
- 7. Music equipment
- 8. Transportation materials and equipment
- 9. Gross motor equipment
- 10. Sensory motor equipment
- 11. School age children were not provided sufficient equipment and materials in at least five of the first nine categories above.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to post the fire and weather alert plan with a diagram.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the following information was not posted for item numbers 2 & 3 below:

- 1. Fire alert plan, including a diagram indicating evacuation routes.
- 2. Weather alert plan was missing details for where to meet, it was cut off...
- 3. Weather alert plan was missing a diagram indicating evacuation routes.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan

Code: The program is required to post the completed JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" and implement as required by rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental and General Emergency Plan" were not followed as noted in numbers 1 below:

- 1. The plan was not posted on each level of the home used for child care.
- 2. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.
- 3. The location of the first aid kit, fire extinguisher and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.
- 4. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency and police department were not complete.
- 5. Location of children's records was not complete.
- 6. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed i the event of an evacuation was not complete.
- 7. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
- 8. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-17 Programming

Code: The program is required to have a daily schedule posted in a visible place.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the daily schedule was not posted/in a visible place in the program. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the Ohio Communicable Disease Chart was not posted as required, as indicated in the number 2 below:

- 1. In a location readily available to provider, child care staff members, employees, and residents;
- 2. The chart was not posted.
- 3. The posted chart was not the current version and the Child Care Manual Procedural Letter No. 159 was not posted next to the chart.
- 4. The posted chart was not displayed in the size available in the ODJFS forms central to be easily read.
