Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment
Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Carbon Monoxide Detectors - Type B Only
Code: The program is required to meet all requirements for carbon monoxide detectors.
Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the Type B Home did not have a working carbon monoxide detector in the basement and on the main level (the program space.) A working carbon monoxide detector must be placed, installed, tested, and maintained in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-02 Provider Medical



Code: The provider is required to submit a complete and valid medical statement.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statement for the provider did not include the required information listed below in number 1:

- 1. Date of examination;
- 2. Signature, business address, and telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination;
- 3. A statement that verifies that the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment as a provider caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR).
- c. Immunized against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (Tdap).

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed medical statement, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any item and condition which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item and condition which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following numbers 1 and 22 below:

- 1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers in the program room to the left of the window.
- 2. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 3. Toys or other items small enough to be swallowed were present in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care.
- 4. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 5. Stacked chairs.
- 6. Telephone cords.
- 7. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 8. Diaper bags.
- 9. Television not securely anchored.
- 10. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 11. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 12. Chipping or peeling paint.
- 13. An area rug did not have a nonskid backing.
- 14. An area rug presented a tripping hazard.
- 15. A floor surface was unsafe in that [].
- 16. No platform was provided for the sink or toilet.



- 17. The platform provided for the sink or toilet was not sturdy.
- 18. The platform provided for the sink or toilet posed a safety hazard in that [].
- 19. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture in that [].
- 20. A mercury thermometer was being used to take a child's temperature.
- 21. Methods of ventilation used did not provide protection from rodents, insects, or other hazards.
- 22. Scented plug in, plugged in to the right of the front door behind the couch in the living room.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-13 Clean environment and equipment

Code: The program is required to have all required items in the restroom(s) and keep them sanitary.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in the following number 3 below, were in the program restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet tissue.
- 3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet was not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other [].

The restroom must be kept sanitary at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 First Aid Kit/Standard Precautions

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit onsite as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit was missing the items listed in numbers 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, 13 and 16 below:

1. One roll of first-aid tape;



- 2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze;
- squares in assorted sizes;
- 3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
- 4.Tweezers;
- 5. Gauze rolled bandage;
- 6. Triangular bandage;
- 7. Rounded end scissors;
- 8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);
- 9. A working digital thermometer;
- 10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
- 11. A working flashlight;
- 12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;
- 13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;
- 14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;
- 15. Waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);
- 16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks

Code: The program is required to post the current menu in a noticeable location that is accessible to parents and note any substitutions at the time of the change.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu did not meet the requirement as noted in number 1 below.

- 1. The menu was not posted.
- 2. The posted menu was not in a visible place readily accessible to parents.
- 3. The menu was not currently dated.
- 4. The entire menu was substituted.
- 5. At least one item on menu did not match what was served.
- 6. The meal or snack served did not match the posted menu.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Domain: 06 Program Information

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Driver Requirements

Code: The program is required to have all drivers be an employee or child care staff member of the program, a public transportation driver, or employed by a contracted transportation service company and retain a copy of all licenses for drivers employed by the program. Only a child care staff member or employee may transport children without the provider present, except parents may transport children for field trips.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the requirements for drivers was not met as listed in number 2 below:

- 1. The driver noted on the Employee Record Chart used for trips did not have a copy of a current driver's license on file.
- 2. At least one employee or child care staff member (provider) who is responsible for transporting children did not have documentation of completion of the prescribed driver training on file.
- 3. The driver used to transport children was not an employee or child care staff member of the program, a public transportation driver, or employed by a company contracted to provide transportation service.
- 4. The driver who was not a child care staff member or employee who is used in accordance with the requirements in rule 5101:2-13-08 transported children without the provider present.

Remove this individual from transporting children until the requirements are met. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
