Rule: 5180:2-13-03 Inspection Requirements

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program had not responded to the non-compliances addressed in the inspection report dated 4/14/2025. The rule requires the program complete and submit a



corrective action plan in OCLQS to address non-compliances detailed in written inspection reports within the timeframe outlined in the report. Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number(s) 1 and 2 below:

- 1. No attendance record was being maintained.
- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed.
- 3. The record did not include the name of at least one child.
- 4. The record did not include the birth date of at least one child.
- 5. The record did not include the assigned group.
- 6. The record did not include the child's weekly schedule.
- 7. The record did not include the time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.
- 8. The original attendance record was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to have running water below the temperature of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the water temperature was 140 degrees in the following room(s) restroom on first floor. This temperature exceeds the requirement of remaining below 120 degrees Fahrenheit. - 2. The chart was not posted.
- 3. The posted chart was not the current version and the Child Care Manual Procedural Letter No. 159 was not posted next to the chart.
- 4. The posted chart was not displayed in the size available in the ODJFS forms central to be easily read.
