Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-12-17 Daily Outdoor Play

Code: The program is required to provide daily outdoor play for all children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that daily outdoor play was not provided for the Airport group. The rule requires daily outdoor play in suitable weather for any infant over twelve months of age, toddler, preschool and school-age child in attendance four or more consecutive daylight hours. Suitable weather is at a minimum of twenty-five to ninety degrees Fahrenheit. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180:2-12-23 Diapering and Toilet Training

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to follow diaper changing procedures.

<u>Finding</u>: During this inspection, it was determined that proper diaper changing procedures were not followed as a common container (the diaper pail lid) became contaminated. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Rule: 5180:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program is required to obtain written instructions from parents regarding feeding their infant.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that written instructions for feeding the infants noted on the Children Record Review were missing information as noted in number 5 below:

- 1. Written instructions were not on file.
- 2. Type of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
- 3. Amount of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
- 4. Feeding times or frequency of feedings was missing.
- 5. The written instructions on file had not been updated.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in numbers 2, 3, 4 & 6 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the name(s) of the child care staff member(s) who must complete the required health and safety training(s). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-15 Medical/Physical Care Plans

Code: The program is required to maintain a complete JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child

Care" on file for any child having a health condition.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the children's records, it was determined that the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The JFS 01236 had not been updated as needed and at least annually.
- 2. A separate JFS 01236 had not been used for each condition.
- 3. The program used an old version of the JFS 01236.

In addition, please ensure that the care plan includes clear instructions regarding the steps to perform the procedures that are consistent with the medication/written instructions. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to ensure that there is at least one child care staff member who has signed the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" caring for the child at all times when a child with a health condition is present.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined a child with a condition that required a JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" had been present and the program did not ensure there was at least one child care staff member caring for the child at all times who had signed the JFS 01236 on the child's condition. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
