Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment



Rule: 5180:2-12-12 Safe Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to use equipment, that is safe and hazard free, according to the manufacturer's guidelines. Fans, air conditioners, heat pumps, and space heaters must be inaccessible to children. The program is required to refrain from using trampolines, ball pits and inflatable equipment intended for climbing and bouncing, including but not limited to slides and bounce houses.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, equipment was determined to be unsafe, hazardous to children, or in need of repair as noted in number 18 below:

- 1. Manufacturer's guidelines for the [ ] were not followed in that [ ].
- 2. The straps were missing on the [ ].
- 3. The straps were attached, but were not used on the [ ].
- 4. The straps were attached and were used, but were not used in a safe manner.
- 5. The equipment had sharp points or corners.
- 6. The equipment had splinters.
- 7. The equipment had protruding nails.
- 8. The equipment had loose or rusty parts.
- 9. The equipment had paint which contains lead or other poisonous materials.
- 10. The equipment had hazardous features.
- 11. A fan was unstable and could easily tip over.
- 12. A fan had openings a finger could enter.
- 13. The pipes from the heat pump felt hot to the touch
- 14. A space heater felt hot to the touch
- 15. The position of a space heater was a tripping hazard
- 16. The air conditioning unit was not enclosed and was accessible to children on the playground.
- 17. A ball pit, trampoline, inflatable bounce house, inflatable slide, or inflatable equipment used for climbing and bouncing was used.
- 18. Two tall cabinets (metal lockers) were not fastened to the wall, providing a tipping hazard.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not providing a clean and healthy environment, furniture, materials and equipment as required by Appendix A, as noted in numbers 13, 19, 23 below:



- 1. Item(s) soiled with blood or bodily fluids were not cleaned/sanitized immediately.
- 2. Blankets/sheets were not cleaned weekly, when soiled, or before use by another child.
- 3. Children's individual blankets and belongings were stored in an unsanitary manner.
- 4. Bottles, bottle caps, nipples and other equipment used for bottle feeding were not cleaned and sanitized in a dishwasher or by washing, rinsing, and boiling for one minute.
- 5. Carpets were not vacuumed weekly or cleaned when soiled.
- 6. Changing table/pad was not sanitized after each use or cleaned when visibly soiled.
- 7. Reusable cloths were not being washed daily or when visibly soiled.
- 8. Cots/Pads/Mats were not cleaned and sanitized before assigning to a different child, when used by a sick child, when soiled or at least every three months.
- 9. Cribs were not cleaned and sanitized monthly, or when soiled, or before use by another child.
- 10. Diaper Receptables were not cleaned and sanitized daily or more frequently as needed to eliminate odor.
- 11. Dishes/Cups/Silverware were not cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- 12. Water Containers were not labeled with the child's name, or were not cleaned and sanitized before use again on another day.
- 13. Stepstools were not clean.
- 14. Dress up clothes and hats (dramatic play) were not cleaned monthly or when soiled.
- 15. Floors were not cleaned weekly or when soiled.
- 16. The food prep area, including sinks, were not cleaned before and after preparing food (including bottle preparation) or between preparing raw or cooked food.
- 17. Potty chairs were not cleaned after each use, rinsed with water, cleaned and sanitized or contents were not emptied into a toilet.
- 18. Food tables, highchair trays were not cleaned before and after each use.
- 19. Tables, shelves, children's chairs were visibly soiled or sanitized daily.
- 20. Toilet bowls were not cleaned when visibly soiled or sanitized weekly.
- 21. Toilet seat(s), handle(s) and hand washing sink(s) were not cleaned when visibly soiled or sanitized daily.
- 22. Mouthed toys were not cleaned and sanitized after each child's use.
- 23. Toys throughout center were not clean.
- 24. Washable furniture, including fabrics on infant equipment, were not cleaned weekly or when soiled.
- 25. Upholstered furniture was not steam cleaned when soiled.
- 26. Slip covers were not washed at least every six months or when soiled.
- 27. Wastebaskets/rinse buckets, including lids, were not being emptied daily or cleaned and sanitized when visibly soiled.
- 28. The manufacturer's directions for the cleaning product were not followed.
- 29. The solution used for sanitizing was not a commercial product registered by the United States Environmental Protection Agency as a sanitizer.
- 30. Other [ ].

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the department that verifies compliance with the rule requirements.

Code: The program is required to have quiet areas available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's environment did not provide for a quiet area in the school age classroom. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the department that verifies compliance with the rule requirements.

Rule: 5180:2-12-17 Daily Schedule

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have the daily program schedule posted in all required areas.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a copy of the daily program schedule was not posted in the Infant & Toddler areas as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the department that verifies compliance with the rule requirements.

#### **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5180:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide equipment appropriate for the children in the program in sufficient quantities that all children can be actively involved. Play materials must be accessible to the children and arranged in an orderly manner.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment, materials and furnishings provided for indoor and outdoor play did not meet the requirement of the rule as noted in number 3 below.

- 1. Equipment and materials were not varied and adequate to meet the developmental needs of the children.
- 2. Equipment and materials were not provided in a sufficient quantity that each child can be actively involved in an activity.
- 3. Play materials were not readily accessible to the children in that several items were still in plastic wrap and/or not opened.
- 4. Play materials were not arranged in an orderly manner so that children have opportunities to select, remove and replace play materials with minimal assistance during the day in the [ ] classroom.



5. Durable, child-sized or safely adapted furniture was not provided for children in the [ ] classroom.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the department that verifies compliance with the rule requirements.

## Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from trash and foreign objects.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the outdoor play space was not free of trash or foreign objects as noted in number 10 below:

- 1. The outdoor area was littered with trash.
- 2. The trash can was missing a lid.
- 3. The trash can was not emptied from the day(s) before.
- 4. The trash can was overflowing with trash.
- 5. The trash can was infested with insects.
- 6. The trash can was visibly dirty.
- 7. There was broken glass.
- 8. There were tall weeds.
- 9. There was poison ivy.
- 10. There were tree branches and a pile of brush.
- 11. There was mold visible.
- 12. There were thistles with prickers.
- 13. There were bird droppings.
- 14. The sandbox was contaminated.
- 15. Other [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-08 Medical Statement



Code: The program staff's medical statements are required to be completed and on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for the employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not meet the requirements as listed in number 1 below.

- 1. A medical statement was not on file for two employees;
- 2. The medical statement(s) on file did not have a date of examination within 12 months of the employee's first day of employment;
- 3. Date of examination was missing;
- 4. Signature, business address, or telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination was missing;
- 5. A statement was missing that verifies the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 6. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test information was missing:
- a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the world health organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment.
- b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 6a.
- c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test.
- d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-08 Child Care Staff Member Educational Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to have educational verification on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that verification of a high school education for the child care staff member(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart, did not meet the requirements as listed in number 1 below:

- 1. Verification of completion of a high school education was not on file.
- 2. Documentation was incomplete or not on file for a high school junior or senior who is enrolled in a career-technical program.
- 3. Documentation was not on file for a high school junior or senior who is also enrolled in a college credit program in child development or early childhood education.



4. Documentation was not on file for a high school junior or senior who is enrolled in a Child Development Associate (CDA) training program.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the education verification, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5180:2-12-08 Orientation Training & Whistle Blower Protection

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training. Additionally, the training must be completed before they are permitted to have sole responsibility of children.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that child care staff member(s) did not meet the requirements for completing the online orientation training as noted in number 4 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within 30 days of starting employment at the program as a child care staff member.
- 2. Documentation of completing the training after December 31, 2016 was not on file.
- 3. Completion of the training was not verified in the OPR.
- 4. A child care staff member will have sole responsibility of children and had not completed the online orientation.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
