# **Moderate Risk Non-Compliances**

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180:2-12-20 Cribs

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide cribs that meet the standards specified by the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission for all infants in attendance. Cribs must be stable and have bars that meet the spacing and size requirements listed in rule. The program is required to refrain from stacking cribs that are used for sleeping infants.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one crib in the infant area did not meet the standards set forth in the rule and the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) safety standards as noted in number(s) 8 below:

- 1. The crib was manufactured prior to June 28, 2011 and the program did not have a certificate of compliance on file.
- 2. The crib was broken.
- 3. The crib was missing hardware.
- 4. The crib was leaning and/or not stable.
- 5. The crib had corner posts that exceeded more than one sixteenth of an inch above the top of the end panel.
- 6. The spaces between the bars of the crib, or between the bars and end panels of a crib, exceeded two and three-eighths inches.
- 7. Stacked cribs were used for a sleeping infant. Repair or replace the crib(s).
- 8. The crib did not have a manufacture date and did not have a certificate of compliance on file.



Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-09 Background Check Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all staff request background checks as required and receive a JFS 01176 or preliminary approval from ODJFS prior to allowing an individual to engage in assigned duties or be near children.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background checks did not meet the requirements of the rule for the person(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The request for a background check for child care was not submitted in the OPR.
- 2. The fingerprints were not submitted electronically according to the process established by BCI.
- 3. The individual(s) had engaged in assigned duties or were near children and preliminary approval from ODJFS was not on file.
- 4. Background checks were not updated every five years.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the JFS 01176, or a copy of the preliminary approval or a statement that the individual(s) are no longer engaged in assigned duties and are not near children until the preliminary approval has been received, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-18 Ratio

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the staff to child ratios, age grouping, and maximum group size appendix in a noticeable area in the program.



<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection it was determined that Appendix A of this rule, "Staff/Child Ratios, Age Grouping and Maximum Group Size", was not posted in a noticeable area in the program. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Rule: 5180:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number(s) 22 and 23 below:

- 1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers.
- 2. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 3. Toys or other items small enough to be swallowed were present in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care.
- 4. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 5. Stacked chairs.
- 6. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 7. Diaper bags.
- 8. Television not securely anchored.
- 9. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 10. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 11. An area rug did not have a nonskid backing.
- 12. An area rug presented a tripping hazard.
- 13. A floor surface that was unsafe in that [ ].
- 14. No platform was provided for the sink or toilet in the [ ] classroom.
- 15. The platform provided for the sink or toilet in the [ ] classroom was not sturdy.
- 16. The platform provided for the sink or toilet in the [ ] classroom posed a safety hazard in that [ ].
- 17. Telephone cords.
- 18. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 19. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [ ].
- 20. A mercury thermometer was being used to take a child's temperature.
- 21. Methods of ventilation used did not provide protection from rodents, insects, or other hazards.
- 22. There was no barrier to keep children from entering the kitchen.
- 23. There was no barrier to keep infants and toddlers in the classroom space.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide cribs with mattresses in good condition and sheets that are not too

large or too small for the crib.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that sheets, mattresses and/or mattress covers did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number(s) 5 and 7 below:

- 1. At least one crib did not have a sheet.
- 2. At least one sheet was too large.
- 3. At least one sheet was too small.
- 4. At least one sheet was torn.
- 5. The mattress was not at least one and one-half inches thick (3 mattresses).
- 6. The mattress was not firm.
- 7. There was space between the mattress and the sides and end panels of the crib which exceeded one and one-half inches (1 mattress).
- 8. The mattress cover was not waterproof.
- 9. The mattress cover was torn.
- 10. Other: [].

- 2. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member had not created an employment record for the program on or before their first day of employment.
- 3. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member had not updated changes to positions or roles within five calendar days of the change.
- 4. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard.
- 5. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 6. At least one individual's position or role did not include an applicable group assignment.
- 7. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 8. Other: [ ]

- 2. The JFS 01176 on file was for a different program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for the employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not meet the requirements as listed in number(s) 2 and 6 b below:

- 1. A medical statement was not on file for at least one employee;
- 2. The medical statement(s) on file did not have a date of examination within 12 months of the employee's first day of employment;
- 3. Date of examination was missing;
- 4. Signature, business address, or telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination was missing;
- 5. A statement was missing that verifies the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 6. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test information was missing:
- a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the world health organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment.
- b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 6a.
- c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test.
- d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
